c. How should we respond to suffering, trials and temptations?

5. Faith is a journey of small steps. What small steps can I take to begin living in the confidence that *all things really do work for my good if I love God, and have been called for His purposes?*

a. What fears should I release to God?

b. What leaps of faith should I take for God?
